Re: Florida Uniform Certification Program (UCP) Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Certification

Dear Mr. Mundy:

Effective July 1, 2005, the United State Department of Transportation recipient agencies in Florida, including Miami-Dade and Orange Counties, begin participating in the UCP. What this means to you is that your DBE certification will be handled through only one agency, but will be valid throughout the state with UCP members.

Because of the nature of your work, and its location The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will henceforth be the responsible certifying member of the UCP for your firm. All matters pertaining to DBE certification will be addressed to, through and by the FDOT.

FDOT will maintain your DBE certification file, notify you of the need to continue your eligibility and is the agency which questions, changes in status, and general concerns must be addressed.

Effective July 1, 2005, all DBE firms in Florida will be listed in a single DBE UCP directory. The directory is found at http://www.bipincwebapps.com/biznetflorida/. Once you are certified, you should visit the website and if for some reason your business name does not appear, or you find the information inaccurate, you should contact FDOT immediately.
